September 15, 2017

Official Minutes will be approved at next Board Meeting, December 1, 2017

- Staff reported to the Board a stronger Financial Balance Sheet for the year ending on June 30, 2017 over the year ending on June 30, 2016.
- Staff reported to the Board that we are working actively with four (4) school districts on their Health Benefits and two (2) more districts are coming on line.
- Staff reported to the Board that the 2017-2018 SEAC Management Negotiators Certification Programs are scheduled for both Northern California in Sacramento and Southern California in Cerritos.
- Staff reported to the Board a new SEAC service to members. The service is reviews of contract language.
- The Board took action on several legislative proposals.
 - **Watch** position on SB751 (Hill). The reserve cap. This is headed to the Governor's Office and there is a good chance he will sign it.
 - **Oppose** position on SB328 (Portantino). Classes start time no earlier than 8:30 a.m. This did not get out of the Assembly and probably will not be considered again until after the first of the year.
 - **Oppose** position on AB1217 (Bocanegra). Creation of a state-run charter school. The author withdrew the bill and it is now inactive.
 - **Oppose unless Amended** SB550 (Pan). Requiring school employers to pay attorney fees to employee organizations under certain circumstances. This is headed to the Governor's Office and there is a good chance he will sign it.
- The Board adopted the Final SEAC Budget for 2017-2018 with a 12.5% Reserve.
